

## Monastic Litany of the Holy Names

*This is a slight variation on the "Litany of the Holy Names of Jehovih", but with the use of a 33 bead/knot prayer rope. The verses are from or based on the Oahspe Bible. There is no obligation for monastics to undertake this practice, however, a monastery may require it of its members.*

*First large bead:*

In the Name of Jehovih. *(make the Sign)* Amen.

Jehovih, Who rulest in heaven and earth, hallowed be Thy Name, and reverent amongst men. Sufficient unto me is my bread, and as much as I forgive those that trespass against me, so make Thou me steadfast to shun temptation, for all honour and glory are Thine, worlds without end. Amen.

*On each of the ten beads:*

Jehovih, my King, Thou art over all and within all.  
R. O Jehovih my Creator, have mercy on me, a sinner.

Elohim, my King, Thou art over all and within all.  
R. O Jehovih my Creator, have mercy on me, a sinner.

Eoih, my King, Thou art over all and within all.  
R. O Jehovih my Creator, have mercy on me, a sinner.

Wenohim, my King, Thou art over all and within all.  
R. O Jehovih my Creator, have mercy on me, a sinner.

Eolin, my King, Thou art over all and within all.  
R. O Jehovih my Creator, have mercy on me, a sinner.

Egoquim, my King, Thou art over all and within all.  
R. O Jehovih my Creator, have mercy on me, a sinner.

Ormazd, my King, Thou art over all and within all.

All Light, my King, Thou art over all and within all.

*On the next two large beads we recite Joshu's Prayer:*

Jehovih, Who rulest in heaven and earth, hallowed be Thy Name, and reverent amongst men. Sufficient unto me is my bread, and as much as I forgive those that trespass against me, so make Thou me steadfast to shun temptation, for all honour and glory are Thine, worlds without end. Amen.

*After coming back to the first large bead, we conclude by reciting:*

Jehovih, Thou art the Potent and Unseen; Thy Ever-Presence quickeneth into life all that live.  
I am Thy servant, O Jehovih, my King. Guide me and give me wisdom according to Thy Will.  
In the Name of Jehovih. *(make the Sign)* Amen.
